	Snorkel sessions: 10am, 11:30am, 1pm – registrations essential
	Marine Metre Squared sessions: 10am, 11:30am, 1pm – register on day
	Please arrive 20mins prior to your registered time in your swimwear
What:	Snorkelling in Otago Harbour – Marine Metre Squared Workshops and a chance to win a trip for two to the Poor Knights Islands
Where:	Aramoana, location TBC – either The Mole or the Harbour side of Aramoana Beach.
Bring:	Togs, towel, sunhat, warm clothes, raincoat, water bottle, a picnic lunch, your own snorkel equipment if you have it.
Cost :	This event is donate to participate - either cash on the day, online or by donating your time in volunteering on future events.

Bring your own gear or get free hire of our mask, snorkel, fins, hoods and wetsuits. Recommended for everyone 12 years and up. **Younger participants are welcome to attend if they have their own equipment*.

All children under 15 years must be accompanied by an adult beach observer. Experienced guides and advanced safety procedures will be in place on the day.

- They need to attend the snorkel day and a Marine Metre Squared workshop.
